We are, once again, partnering with the City of Redding Recreation Department to provide bocce at our courts in South City Park. To avoid the weather issues of the past, we are go-



ing to have just the spring/summer league play but with some changes. Our regular, and more competitive, 4-person team play will start on Thursday, April 28th and go for 6 weeks to June 2nd. Wednesday 27th will see the start of a social league of 2-person teams with the same 6-week schedule. This is perfect for people who haven't play as much or just like the idea of rolling twice as much. It is also easier to put together a team.

That brings us to our senior league. That will commence on April 28<sup>th</sup> also, but play is at 9:00 the morning. Senior League teams are also 2-person. The entry fee will be \$50 per person in for either of the 3 leagues. All players will need to register themselves on the City of Redding website. We will walk you through that process later. 



